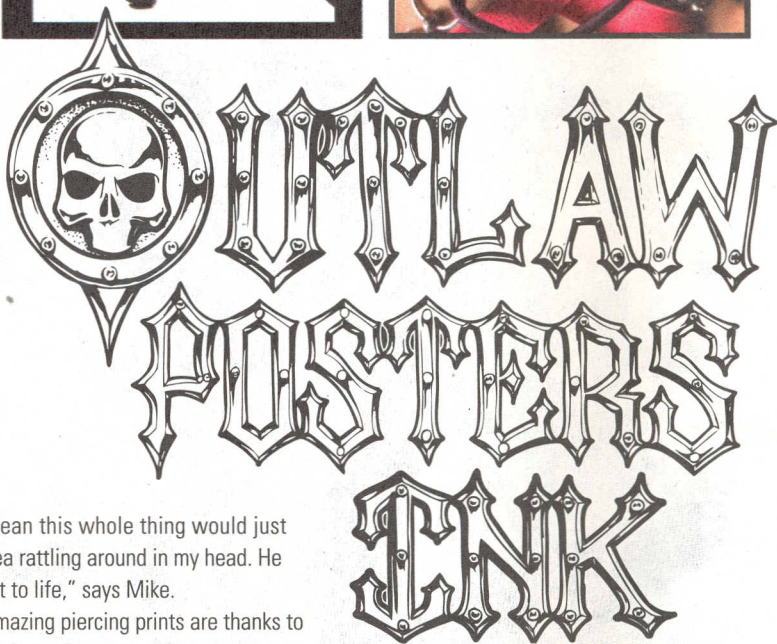
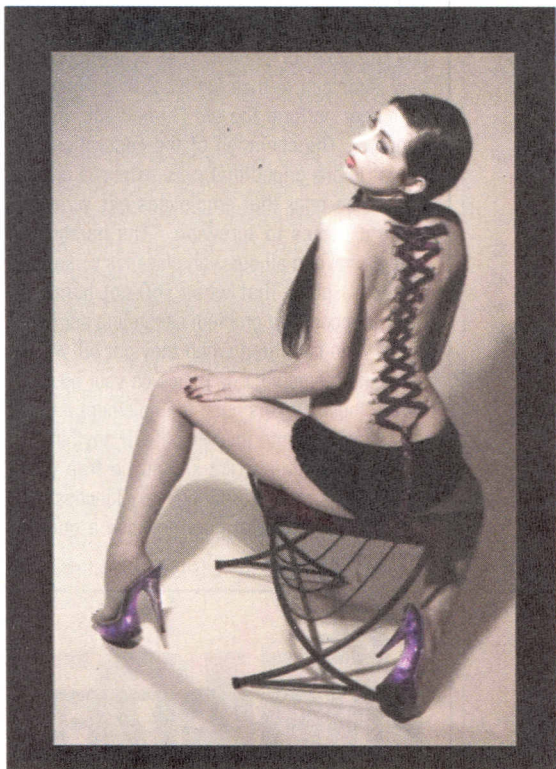


Product Review
